VN-INDEX – New ground creation

- The VN-Index positively reacted with 660 pts zone, stalled the current downtrend.
- Additionally, major MAs are downward sloping which accompanied with the increasing ADX (above 25) → downtrend still maintained.
- Volume rose slightly, notably, massive volume occurred and followed by the Doji (weekly chart) → signaling the potential reversal or new ground creation phase.
- The significant support is 660 pts, followed by 630 pts; if the index closes below these thresholds, it will form the long-term downtrend.

\rightarrow The bearish market still maintained but new ground creation phase could take place this week.
