# **Market commentary**

### Mid-cap and small-cap in the spotlight

After three bullish sessions in a row, Vietnam stock market reversed to closed in red territory as long holidays are coming, Reunification Day and International Labour Day.

At the close, the VNIndex lost 0.76% to close at 770.7 pts. Trading volume increased to 307 million shares or VND4,704bn.

Foreign investors continued to sell with a net value of VND462bn on HSX. They sold VCB, VPB, and VRE heavily with net values of VND106bn, VND82bn, and VND57bn, respectively.

Selling pressure pushed Banking sector down driven by VCB (-3.0%), CTG (-1.8%), BID (-2.5%), MBB (-2.2%), STB (-1.2%), and EIB (-1.3%) because investors expected that their revenue and net income in 2Q20 would go down.

Energy stocks underperformed the benchmark index, such as GAS (-1.4%), PVT (-2.4%), PVD (-3.9%), PLX (-2.8%), and BSR (-3.3%) due to the high volatility of the global oil price.

Short-term speculative flows went into mid- and small-cap tickers namely KBC (+6.7%), VHC (+7.0%), TCH (+3.7%), NKG (+6.9%), SZC (+6.9%), HHS (+6.9%), HAG (+3.6%), and HNG (+1.2%).

▶ U.S. unemployment: Numbers of U.S. unemployment filings increase to more than 26 million within 5 weeks

On the latest number from the U.S. Department of Labor, about 4.4 million U.S. citizens filed for unemployment benefits in the week ended 18th April, taking the total of more than 33 million considered unemployed or the unemployment rate of about 20.6%. Therefore, the COVID-19 pandemic has wiped out all the job gains since the 2008 financial crisis in just 2 months, pushing the unemployment rate to the highest since 1934. However, the worst seemed to behind when several states have been on the way to re-open businesses, which may help the unemployment rate reduce to 16% by the end of April. ► HPG: Agriculture segment pushes HPG performance

Hoa Phat Group (HOSE: HPG) announced the Consolidated Financial Statements for the first quarter of 2020 with revenue of VND19,232bn, up 29% YoY. Particularly, steel production and trading segment recorded the revenue of VND15,591bn, up 31% YoY; notably, agriculture segment increased by 59% YoY, recorded at VND2,779bn. (ndh.vn)
