The short-term rectangle pattern

VN30 performance

The VN30 index was added 0.1% to close at 797 pts. Among top 5 index weight tickers, only HPG (+2.1%) contributed to the index gains whilst VNM (-0.3%), TCB (-0.5%), VPB (-0.2%) and VIC (-1.0%) dragged the benchmark down. Regarding to foreign trading activities, selling pressure ticked up with net sell value recorded at VND105bn. Particularly, VIC, MSN, VCB, VNM and BID were sold the most whilst VHM, PLX, HPG, VRE and NVL attracted most demand on VN30.

VN30 Future chart: The short-term downtrend

VN30F2007 consolidated within the trading range with upside and downside limit placed at 835 pts and 760 pts, respectively. Most importantly, downward crossing between MA20 and MA50 is confirmed, and the bearish market is confirmed. Additionally, on daily time frame, upper Bollinger band hooked down, thereby signaling the diminished upside potential as well as downward swing is expected. Besides, Bollinger bands narrowed on hourly time frame, giving the first signal for intraday consolidation phase where supply and demand are in balance stage. Furthermore, the short-term rectangle pattern was formed with upper and lower threshold placed at 795 pts and 780 pts, respectively. In this case, traders should wait for the breakout/breakdown to capture the long/short positions.

Technical strategy

Short VN30F2007 at 778 pts when the rectangle's lower threshold is broken, take a profit at 760 pts and stop a loss immediately at 785 pts to avoid false breakdown.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics hourly chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




