Uptrend is paused

VN30 performance

The VN30 index downed 1.3%, closed at 803.4 pts. Among top 5 index weight tickers, HPG (-1.9%), VPB (-1.5%), VIC (-1.4%), VNM (-0.9%), and TCB (-0.5%) dragged the benchmark down significantly. Regarding to foreign trading activities, selling activities increased strongly with net sell value recorded at VND176bn. Particularly, HPG, VHM, STB, VRE, and GAS were sold the most whilst SAB, VNM, PLX, CTG, and TCB attracted most demand across VN30.

VN30 Future chart: First bearish sign

VN30F2008 decreased strongly yesterday, fading the breakout at 805 pts level. To be specific, instrument closed below the benchmark for the short-term uptrend – MA20 with downward crossing Stochastic, there is no place for the upward resumption phase. However, the upward crossover between MA50 and MA20, MA50 and MA200 are confirmed, the bearish market is not valid. Notably, as the MA20 and MA50 could not maintain its upward slope, the earliest signals for the bear are given. In this case, traders should open the short positions when 780 pts zone is broken.

Technical strategy

Short VN30F2008 at 780 pts level when valid breakdown occurs at 783 pts zone, take a profit at 740 pts and stop a loss immediately at 790 pts.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics hourly chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




