Trigger the long positions after ATO session

VN30 performance

The VN30 index was added 2.0% to close at 935 pts. Among top 5 index weight tickers, VIC (+3.9%), VPB (+3.5%), HPG (+3.4%), TCB (+2.0%), and VNM (+0.5%) contributed significantly to the index gains. Relating to foreign trading activities, selling activities kept overwhelming with net sell value recorded at VND125bn. Particularly, HDB, VPB, and SAB were sold the most whilst MBB, VHM, and VCB attracted the most demand across VN30.

VN30 Future chart: The next bullish leg

VN30F2011 absorbed the massive demand at 920 pts and rejected to close below MA50, giving signal for the next bullish leg. Particularly, 935-940 pts area plays as the short-term resistance whilst 900 pts area acts as the line in the sand for the upward move. For intraday support zone, 915-920 pts is the significant area. Notably, the instrument has already closed above the major MAs with the above average volume, confirming the validity for the next bullish leg. In this case, traders should open the long positions immediately after ATO session.

Technical strategy

Long VN30F2011 after ATO session, hold the positions until it is expired and stop a loss at 917 pts.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics hourly chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




