Solid across the board in 9M22

Domestic demand revived

- Vietnam Steel Association (VSA) publicized the accelerating Sep steel production volume of 2.25mn tonnes, +25.9% mom, +0.3% yoy. We witnessed a significant improvement of the production for construction and steel pipes products.
- The total consumption volume was slightly down 5.5% mom to 1.83mn tonnes, -11.1% yoy.
- Breaking down domestic sale volume (1.53mn tonnes, +20.9% yoy), we witnessed a solid revival in most products except steel coil products (+18.7% mom but -5.6% yoy).
- The export volume was 294,141 tonnes, -62.6% yoy, hinting at a gloomy global demand
- Steel inventory as of end-Sep surged by 17.1% yoy, 1.48mn tonnes.
- The movements of raw material input prices were mixed in the last 30 days: as of 12 Oct, iron ore was around USD97/mt (-3USD/mt), China hot roll coil (HRC) decreased to USD566/mt (-9USD/mt); Aug hard coking coal increased to USD283/mt (+25USD/mt).
- Based on quoted prices of Hoa Phat steel bar in Sep, the local prices of steel products were VND15.39mn/tonne.

9M22 performance sustained

- Overall, Vietnam produced 21.55mn tonnes in the 9M22, -6.2% yoy. The total sale volume was also encouraging (19.6mn tonnes, -2.8% yoy).

Ratings and recommendation: Neutral on tepid 2022F outlook

 We maintain our Neutral rating on Vietnam's steel sector owing to a lack of in sales volume growth, which might continue to hinder the market's business sales over the next 4 months. Furthermore, the tepid economic growth could cast a shadow on the export performance.

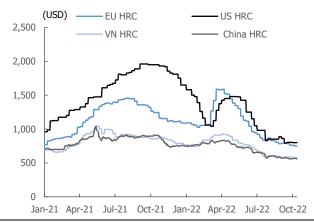

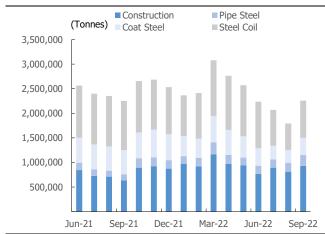

Figure 1. Global HRC prices declined



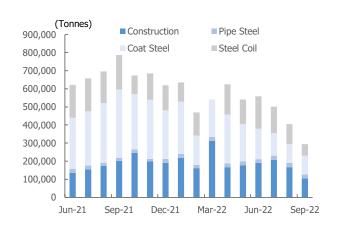

Figure 4. Export volume declined amid slower demand



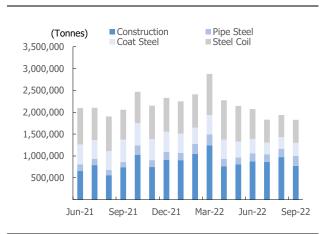

Figure 2. Material input prices were mixed in the last 30 days



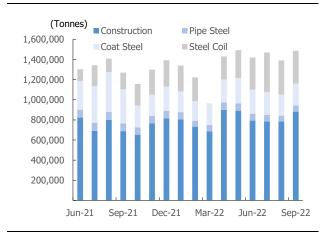

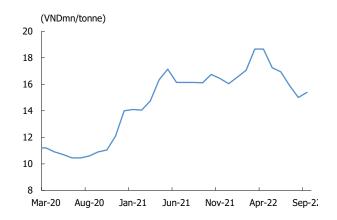
Figure 5. Inventory volume increased
