## Market commentary & News

### Market commentary

#### Selling signal?

Red Bear still dominated the stock market with a 3rd consecutive deep loss by more than 1% session. In which, selling pressure intensified and mainly focused on Real Estate. Moreover, the liquidity was recorded at a high level, showing investors' fear sentiment toward the market.

At the close, the VNIndex lost 1.63% to 1,103 pts while the VN30Index also decreased by 1.36% to close at 1,125 pts. Meanwhile, trading volume reached 977 million shares/ VND21,812bn, up 69%/ 57% respectively, from the average of the last five sessions.

Foreign investors were still net buyers, with more than VND555bn, focusing on STB, PVD, and SSI with net values of VND120bn, VND50bn, and VND50bn, respectively. In contrast, net selling concentrated on VHM, EIB, and VNM with VND33bn, VND26bn, and VND25bn, respectively.

Real Estate was still the worst sector due to almost all tickers falling strongly, like DIG (-6.86%), DXG (-5.49%), NVL (-5.45%), PDR (-3.97%), HDG (-3.85%), VHM (-2.70%), BCM (-2.18%), VRE (-1.85%), NLG (-1.54%), KDH (-1.35%), KBC (-1.14%), VPI (-0.57%), and VIC (-0.45%).

Consumer Staples and Retail tickers were down across the board, typically PAN (-4.75%), VHC (-4.34%), MSN (-3.80%), SBT (-3.57%), MWG (-3.46%), PNJ (-2.65%), SAB (-2.29%), VSF (-1.57%), QNS (-1.45%), and VNM (-1.20%).

Banking had a bad situation among BID (-3.15%), MBB (-1.93%), SHB (-1.89%), ACB (-1.78%), TCB (-1.57%), TPB (-1.52%), VIB (-1.07%), STB (-1.00%), VPB (-0.88%), CTG (-0.87%), and SSB (-0.20%).

Almost all Steel shares plummeted to rock in the session, including HSG (-5.56%), HPG (-3.23%), and NKG (-2.96%). Besides, Oil & Gas was also divested in a deep loss day because of PVB (-4.02%), PAT (-3.19%), PLX (-2.78%), GAS (-2.58%), BSR (-1.90%), and OIL (-1.85%).

Brokerage tickers moved in opposite movements with VDS (-3.23%), FTS (-1.54%), VCI (-1.45%), BSI (-1.30%), DSC (-1.09%), and HCM (-0.18%) loss while VIX (+3.85%), MBS (+1.96%), SHS (+1.85%), VND (+0.75%), and SSI (+0.32%) gain at the end.

In addition, the market also recorded DPM (-5.76%), DCM (-3.77%), DHG (-2.70%), BVH (-1.68%), GVR (-0.99%), and FPT (-0.11%) close in the red territory.

On the other side, PVD (+2.96%), DGW (+2.95%), VJC (+1.94%), IDC (+2.00%), PVS (+1.32%), MCH (+1.04%), and FRT (+0.53%) were the rare bright spots in the session.

Selling pressure continuously intensifies strongly during the session, causing the stock market to experience a 3rd consecutive deep loss session by more than 1% with high liquidity. Notably, the VNIndex ends below the 200-period moving average during the day. That means the downside risk is still present and quite significant. Therefore, investors should reduce a portion of stocks in their portfolio to the safety threshold and wait for the next signal.
